

City of Dayton Yard Sale Permit

- No person shall conduct a yard sale within the city without first filing for a permit.
- No person shall be issued more than two permits per calendar year or for more than three consecutive calendar days.
- The permit shall be prominently displayed at each premise upon which the yard sale is conducted throughout the entire period of the sale.
- Fees for issuance of a yard sale permit: One day \$5 Two or Three days \$10
- No person shall conduct a yard sale on any premises other than the premises stated on the permit.
- No yard sale shall be conducted prior to 7:00 AM nor after 6:00 PM.
- No yard sale shall be conducted in such a manner that goods or wares for sale are placed on any public sidewalk, street, alley, thoroughfare or right-of-way within the city nor in such a manner as to require customers or other interested parties to view those goods or wares from any street, alley, thoroughfare or right-of-way within the City.
- No person shall fasten, place, paint, or attach in any way: any sign, handbill, poster, advertisement, or notice of any kind to any curbstone, lamp post, telephone pole, electric light, hydrant, bridge, culvert, public drinking fountain, public trash container, courtesy benches, tree or in or upon any portion of any public sidewalk or street sign.

Violation of any provision of Chapter 114, 114.02, 114.03, 114.04, or 114.07, is declared to be a civil offense. Any person violating any provision shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00). Any person electing not to contest the citation from said offense shall be fined one hundred dollars (\$100.00). Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.
