ORDINANCE NO. 2021-#5**

**AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE § 91.03,
WHICH ESTABLISHED AN ANIMAL LICENCE FEE**

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton is a pet friendly community. In furtherance of same, the City of Dayton hereby wishes to eliminate the license fee formally imposed upon every dog and cat owner in the City.

WHEREAS, now the City of Dayton is officially a license free animal loving City and;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DAYTON, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. That Ordinance 840.03 passed on 11-18-1986 and amended by Ordinance 1995-5 and passed on 2-21-1995 as codified by City of Dayton Code of Ordinances, Section 91.03 et. seq., is hereby rescinded.

Section II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication as is required by law.


