Order/Resolution: Order /Resolution 2022-#20R- Authorizing the mayor to enter into a contract with Riegler Blacktop in the amount of \$220,417.47 for street repaving projects on seven streets in the City of Dayton. Payable from Municipal Road Aid Funds.

Order/Resolution: Order/Resolution 2022-#21R- Authorizing the City of Dayton, KY, to enter into an agreement with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for funding to construct Phase 2 of the Riverfront Commons Project along the River's Edge. Payable from Federal SNK funds with a 20% match from the City.

Order/Resolution: Order/Resolution 2022-#22R- Declaring City-Owned Real Property located at 1109 Seventh Avenue as surplus property and authorizing the Mayor to sell or otherwise dispose of this property as permitted under Kentucky law.

Order/Resolution: Order/Resolution 2022-#23R- Authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with Adeleta Construction in the amount of \$126,371.79 for a stormwater improvement project at the intersection of Fourth Avenue and Kenton Street. Payable under a 50-50 cost-sharing agreement with SD1, with the city's portion payable from federal ARPA funds.
