Fire Chief's Report for June 2023

FIRE & EMS Report

Response calls: 67 Fire runs and 161 EMS calls were made in June for a total of 228 calls for service.

CPR: There were no CPR classes in June. One was scheduled but canceled at the last minute.

Training: Members have completed 1414 hours of training through June. Training topics this month included Hoses, Nozzles & Appliances, Victim Search & Rescue, Drivers Training, and Fire Control. The EMS for the month was Obstetrics/Gynecological emergencies, and Pediatric Transport/Toxicology emergencies. Training is done year-round.

FIRE INSPECTIONS

Crews completed 9 inspections in June, plus 2 firework stands were approved.

KNOX BOX PROGRAM

BURN PERMITS

No burn permits will be issued until October 1 due to the state-wide burn ban.

PUBLIC ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS.

I attended the first regional planning meeting for the annual WEBN fireworks show in September. There will be several more meetings with every jurisdiction involved before the September 3rd event.

We had our annual KBEMS inspection. Our ambulance, training records and protocols are inspected every year to make sure we are compliant and up to date with our requirements.

Due to Capt Hall's upcoming retirement, we have started the promotional process. This entails a written test, skills assessment for the Lieutenant position, and interviews for both the Lieutenant and Captain spots. We have qualified candidates for both openings.

We have also conducted interviews for the opening we currently have and to replace Capt. Hall. We should be making tentative job offers soon.

The FDBD Fire Board approved our 2023-24 Fiscal Year budget. We would like to thank both cities for their continued support, and we look forward to moving forward in the years to come to keep FDBD in the forefront of Fire and EMS.
