## CITY OF DAYTON, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE NO. 2023#15

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 111.12 OF THE DAYTON CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING THE TIMES WHEN RETAIL SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF DAYTON, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section §111.12 of Chapter 111, Alcoholic Beverages, of the City of Dayton Code of Ordinances is hereby amended, with words being deleted being lined through and words being added <u>underlined</u>, as follows:

## § 111.12 TIMES WHEN RETAIL SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED.

No person, with or without an alcoholic beverage license, shall by act or omission cause, permit, allow, aid, assist, encourage or engage in the retail sale of any distilled spirits, wine or malt beverages in the City of Dayton during the period of time:

(A) On any Sunday after 12:00 a.m. and before <u>116</u>:00 a.m., only if <u>the seller of the alcoholic</u> <u>beverages possesses</u> in possession of a special Sunday retail drink license; or

(B) On any other day after 12:00 a.m. and before 6:00 a.m., unless <u>the seller of the alcoholic</u> <u>beverages possesses in possession of</u> an extended hours supplemental license, which shall allow the <u>holder of said</u> license <u>holder</u> to remain open until 2:00 a.m.
