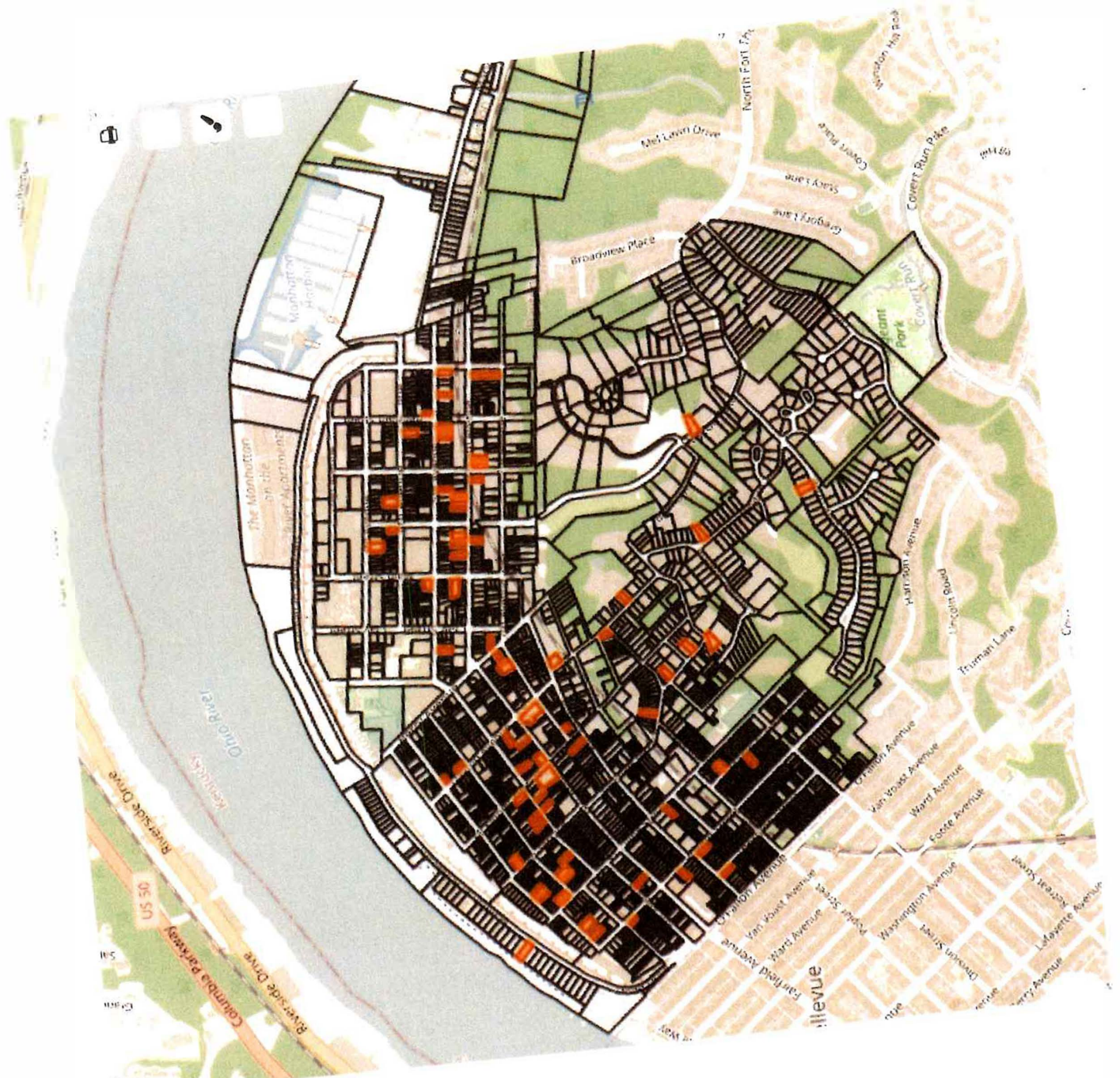

Fire Chief's Report for August 2023

### **FIRE & EMS Report**

**Response calls:** 49 Fire runs, and 125 EMS calls were made in August for a total of 174 calls for service.

**CPR:** There weren't any CPR classes in August. CPR classes are available if citizens call and ask.

**Training:** Members have completed 1515 hours. Training topics this month included Boat Operations, Ground Ladders, Hoselines, 12 Lead EKG's & Traction-splinting. Training continues for everyone.

### **FIRE INSPECTIONS**

Crews completed 12 inspections in August.

### **KNOX BOX PROGRAM**

There were no new Knox Boxes installed in August.

### **BURN PERMITS**

No burn permits will be issued until October 1 due to the state-wide burn ban.

### **PUBLIC ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS.**

Our new hires are on shift and working out great. We are throwing a lot of information and training at them, and they are eager and willing to learn. They should be valuable assets to the cities for years to come.

We finished up our promotions after a rigorous testing process. Firefighter/EMT Dan McGraw was promoted to Lieutenant, and Lieutenant/Medic Nick Scott was promoted to Captain. Both officers will be strong additions to our command staff.

We are continuing to do our fire drills with the schools. We are in frequent communication with the staff of all the schools, and work with them to keep the kids safe. I attended a two-day "Medical Management of CBRNE events" class. This class is

part of a larger 4 class curriculum for Community Health Planning certificate. I will be taking the other two in the upcoming months.

Riverfest is right around the corner, and we have attended several planning meetings. We will have our fireboat on the river, and I will be on duty in the area during the event. I am also part of the Campbell County command staff, as the MCU liaison, in the event of a mass casualty event.
