Fire Chief's Report for September 2023

### **FIRE & EMS Report**

**Response calls:** 67 Fire runs, and 156 EMS calls were made in September for a total of 223 calls for service.

**CPR:** There was one CPR class in September. CPR classes are available if citizens call and ask.

**Training:** Members have completed over 2000 hours of training. Several topics were covered this month as we get our new hires up to speed. Training continues for everyone.

### **FIRE INSPECTIONS**

Crews completed 12 inspections in September.

### **KNOX BOX PROGRAM**

There were no new Knox Boxes installed in September.

### **BURN PERMITS**

No burn permits will be issued until October 1 due to the state-wide burn ban.

### **PUBLIC ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS.**

The new hires continue to train. They are fitting in and are turning into valuable assets for the department.

After the promotional process and shift changes, everyone is settling into their new shifts and roles. With our new hires, the crews are constantly training, doing walk-throughs, and street/road familiarizations.

We have been assisting the schools with some room labeling. This is to make it easier for identification in the event of an incident at the schools.

Riverfest has come and gone for another year. Thankfully there were no issues, and the day was uneventful, beyond the normal calls.

I attended a FEMA/DHS “Medical Countermeasures: Point of Dispensing, Planning & Response” two-day class. This class is part of a 4-class training course. I will finish this training and receive a certificate in December.

We will be starting the winterization of the fire hydrants in the next few weeks. This is done every fall to ensure the hydrants are lubricated, dry, and functioning properly. An added benefit is that the crews become familiar with the locations of the hydrants in the cities.

<b>6-453 Dayton Riverfront Commons Ph 2</b> 12' wide concrete bicycle/pedestrian trail and conduit for future lighting from Berry Street to Fourth Avenue. [Designer is KZF]	SNK application submitted 6/2 for the gap in funding. PRIME putting together fee proposal for design modifications that will reduce construction costs and can be reimbursed 80%. We will hear back for sure the first week of October 10. Timing may work out to bid phases 2 and 3 together. We also found out SD1 has money in esgrow to put towards the path.
<b>6-462 Dayton Riverfront Commons Ph 3 - Eastern Trail</b> Continuation of Riverfront Commons multi-use path between Berry Street and Fourth Avenue (KY 8).	Plans are going through final review. It would be ideal to advertise this project to construction the same time as the phase 2 rebid.
<b>6-3505 6th Street Bumpouts - construct bumpouts and install lighting along 6th Street</b>	Work complete. Need to fix awning and finalize invoice quantities.
<b>6-3228 Dayton Pike Sidewalk Connector (Ph 2)</b> New 1500' of 5' sidewalk along west side of Dayton Pike	New stormwater improvements will not tie into the existing poor/private system and will remove water from the existing system. Utility poles are being relocated to the other side of the street to make room for the sidewalk. Curb and gutter will be added for safety and to help with stormwater collection. Plans are 90% complete and we are working with property owners on driveway grade concerns.
<b>Upper Riverfront Commons Trail Improvements</b> Improve the existing trail at the top of the earthen levee that runs along the south side of Manhattan Boulevard	The upper trail grant application was not awarded through KYTC. We submitted for a TA grant to KYTC and haven't heard back yet. New SNK application was submitted 6/2/23 but removed to improve our chances for the phase 2 funding. Will resubmit next cycle. Southbank is also working on trying to get funding for this project.
