Fire Chief's Report for February 2024

#### FIRE & EMS Report

**Response calls:** 47 Fire runs, and 113 EMS calls were made in February for a total of 160 calls for service.

**CPR:** Members taught 3 CPR classes in February. We will be scheduling some community CPR classes in the upcoming months.

**Training:** Members have completed 294 hours of training through the month of February. Topics included Search & Rescue, Fire Instructor, Haz-Mat, Incident Safety Officer, Ventilation, and FF Rescue. The EMS training included Medication review and psychological emergencies. Our training requirements restart every January and include at least 100 hours of Fire, and 40 hours of EMS training per person.

#### FIRE INSPECTIONS

Crews completed 14 inspections in February.

#### KNOX BOX PROGRAM

No new Knox Boxes were installed in February.

#### **BURN PERMITS**

No burn permits were issued in February. Any open burning within the city limits must have a burn permit issued from the fire department.

#### PUBLIC ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS.

Lt. Lynn completed his training and testing to be certified as a level 1 Fire Instructor. Lt. McGraw attended training to obtain his Incident Safety Officer certification. I attended a regional School Safety meeting at NKU. Multiple agencies from fire, police, emergency management and school administrations attended and heard several speakers from the NKY Health Department, KSP and the NKY Drug task force talk about the state of school safety in the region.

We had the Bellevue Visioning session, and on-duty crews attended the Winter Carnival and were judges for the chili contest. We will be hosting a 40-hour Driver/Apparatus Operator/Water-Supply class in April for all members and some members from surrounding departments.
