Fire Chief's Report for March 2024

FIRE & EMS Report

Response calls: 45 Fire runs, and 122 EMS calls were made in March for a total of 167 calls for service.

CPR: Members taught 4 CPR classes in March. We will be scheduling some community CPR classes in the upcoming months.

Training: Members have completed 400 hours of training through the month of March. Topics included Emergency/Disaster Training, Electric Vehicle Fire, Pump Ops/Water Supply, and Fire Protection Systems (sprinklers/standpipes). The EMS training for the month was Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma, CPR, and Oxygenation/Ventilation. Our training requirements restart every January and include at least 100 hours of Fire, and 40 hours of EMS training per person.

FIRE INSPECTIONS

Crews completed 7 inspections in March.

KNOX BOX PROGRAM

No new Knox Boxes were installed in March.

BURN PERMITS

No burn permits were issued in March. Any open burning within the city limits must have a burn permit issued from the fire department.

PUBLIC ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS.

I attended the Dayton Strategic Planning session to go over the previous years' activities and to discuss the upcoming budget proposals. As with Bellevue, these conversations are ongoing. I also attended a table-top training session at Tyson Foods. As the Campbell County representative for the Northern Ky Hazardous Materials response team, we meet with businesses and companies to plan for hazardous materials responses.

We had our annual Ky Board of EMS inspection, which goes over our ambulance, supplies, and training records. Once again, we passed with no issues. Captain Schafer oversaw ensuring everything was in proper order and should be commended for the extra time and energy that goes into that.

We have our upcoming Driver/Apparatus Operator/Aerial Operations class. This is a 40-hour, two-week class. Besides our members, we have members coming from other agencies in the area. This training is a refresher for our seasoned members and good training for our newer, younger members.
