 - **Second Reading: Ordinance 2024-5:** An Ordinance amending sections 96.15, 96.16, 96.17, 96.18, 96.19, and 96.99 of Title IX, General Regulations of the City of Dayton Code of Ordinances dealing with sidewalk maintenance in the City, including enforcement provisions and penalties for failure to maintain sidewalks.
 - **First Reading: Ordinance 2024-6:** An Ordinance amending Section 32.21 of the Dayton Code of Ordinances to change the dates of City Council Meetings.
 - **First Reading: Ordinance 2024-7:** An Ordinance adopting the City of Dayton, Kentucky's annual budget for the fiscal year running from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025, and estimating revenues and resources and appropriating funds for the City to the full extent authorized by KRS 82.082 and interpretative case law.
 - **First Reading: Ordinance 2024-8:** An ordinance amending Section 33.01 and 33.02 of the Dayton Code of Ordinances to reflect that Fire and EMS services are provided in the City of Dayton by the Fire Department of Bellevue-Dayton, L.L.C., under the terms and conditions set forth in an interlocal agreement entered between the Cities of Dayton and Bellevue, Kentucky, and approved by the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
- **Orders/Resolutions:**
 - **Order Resolution 2024-5R:** An Order/Resolution of the Dayton City Council adopting a sidewalk maintenance policy in conjunction with adoption of a new sidewalk maintenance ordinance.
 - **Order Resolution 2024-7R:** An Order-Resolution authorizing the Mayor to enter into a Municipal Road Aid Co-op Program contract between the City of Dayton, Kentucky, and the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Transportation Cabinet, Department of Rural and Municipal Aid for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2024, as provided in Kentucky Revised Statutes, and accepting all streets referred to therein as being streets which are a part of the incorporated city.
