ORDINANCE NO. 2023#15

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 111.12 OF THE
DAYTON CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING THE
TIMES WHEN RETAIL SALES OF ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF DAYTON, CAMPBELL COUNTY,
KENTUCKY, HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section §111.12 of Chapter 111, Alcoholic Beverages, of the City of Dayton Code of Ordinances is hereby amended, with words being deleted being ~~lined through~~ and words being added underlined, as follows:

§ 111.12 TIMES WHEN RETAIL SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED.

No person, with or without an alcoholic beverage license, shall by act or omission cause, permit, allow, aid, assist, encourage or engage in the retail sale of any distilled spirits, wine or malt beverages in the City of Dayton during the period of time:

(A) On any Sunday after 12:00 a.m. and before 9:00 a.m., only if the seller of the alcoholic beverages possesses a special Sunday retail drink license; or

(B) On any other day after 12:00 a.m. and before 6:00 a.m., unless the seller of the alcoholic beverages possesses an extended hours supplemental license, which shall allow the license holder to remain open until 2:00 a.m.
