Dayton December 2024 Report

Monday 12/2/24 Received a complaint on the cat that belongs to 819 7th. The neighbor is concerned for the cat in this cold weather. I called the owner and the cat has a heated shelter that it does use. Her mother may be taking the cat for the winter. The complainant wants the cat removed from the owner and charged with cruelty. I called the shelter and they agree that the cat is fine with food, water and shelter being an outdoor cat.

Tuesday 12/3/24 received a call from Ft. Thomas police department about a missing dog that was last seen on Route 8 and could be in Dayton. I have the owners phone number and have seen the facebook posts. The dog is a black husky mix with one blue eye. The dog was found!

Wednesday 12/4/24 Received a call that a limping pit bull was running on 6th near Benham. I was able to see the dog. It was not limping, but it was very scared. It was brown and white. Lost sight of it in the 1300 block of 6th.

Thursday 12/5/24 received a call about the brown and white pit bull at 1108 6th. I could not locate him.

Friday 12/6/24 saw the brown and white pit bull going up the steps at 1104 6th. Spoke with a resident and we put food and water out in front of 1108 6th.

Advised owner of a large merle dog at 1302 6th that she needs to keep the dog contained and get it a rabies vaccine. Dog is a neighborhood dog that was left abandoned by its owner.

Saw a Dexter the cattle dog out at 5th and Boone. Followed him home to 808 6th advised owner about rabies vaccine and neuter. Gave her some low cost options.

Wednesday 12/11/24 TNR black male cat from 804 6th.

TNR 2 cats from 409 Kenton. One young female and an older male.

Saturday 12/14/24 3 St. Bernards from 812 Vine attacked the neighbor at 814 Vine. They broke thru the front gate onto the victim's property and it resulted in injury. I received pictures, video, bite report and police report from Dayton police.

Tuesday 12/17/24 Cited Hannah Martinez to court for 2 counts of failing to control dogs and 2 counts of dangerous animals. The 3rd St. Bernard in the video was not an aggressor. Court is 1/7/25 at 8:30.

Wednesday 12/18/24 sent evidence to County attorney and Hannah Martinez.

Friday 12/27/24 Spoke to Amy Drake who is a neighbor of 812 Vine. She was concerned for her kids safety. I explained we had a court date and I was waiting to see what happens in court.

Sunday 12/29/24 Called out for 2 pit bull type dogs on Ervin Terrace. One of the dogs had a microchip. I was able to get ahold of the owner on facebook. She finally called the shelter on January 2nd to claim the dogs.
