Dayton January 2025 Report

Friday 1/3/25 Received a call that there was 7 dogs and 4 cats abandoned at 516 5th. I left a Notice and heard the dogs inside barking, there was a padlock on the outside of the door. I spoke to the owner Susie Newman and she assured me the pets have not been abandoned. She is in a nasty custody battle with 2 former tenants. I also spoke to the landlord and he confirmed the animals are taken care of.

I left a Notice of impound for the Boone county animal shelter at 328 9th for Zeus and Zari.

Monday 1/6/25 I was off due to the snow. 409 Kenton had a dog that was attacking the stray cats. She put the dog in her car. This dog has been picked up before. We found it on facebook. I was able to call dispatch and get the owners address and phone number for his wife. They came and got the dog.

Thursday 1/9/25 Left a Notice at 139 6th for sharp objects in the yard the dog could cut itself on. Someone walking by called dispatch. There was a machete and broken broom with sharp metal edges.

Monday 1/13/25 611 Berry called about their outdoor cat missing. She is a small black cat and got scared by the neighbors dog and has not come back.

Wednesday 1/15/25 the cat from 611 Berry came back.

TNR cat from 1602 #1 Dayton ave.

TNR two male cats from 906 5th.

Friday 1/17/25 Got a call from the shelter about a landlord finding a cat in a house where the tenants moved out. I contacted the former tenant and found out the cat was an outside cat that got in while they had the doors open moving stuff out. I set a trap for the cat. I was able to catch the cat after the shelter was closed. I contacted them Saturday to take the cat until I could get it TNRed. They refused to take the cat. I had to keep it in my garage until I was able to take it to OAR Monday 1/20/25 for TNR and I picked her up on Tuesday 1/21/25. Cat was released back near 1007 7th. Cat was an in heat female Siamese mix.

Wednesday 1/22/25 Saw a post on Facebook about a Rottweiler on McKinney. I called 411 4th to see if his dog was missing. It was. I told him the dog was seen at 5th and McKinney. He was able to get the dog contained. I advised him to get the dog a collar, rabies vaccine and keep it contained.

Received a facebook message about a matted dog running loose on 4th street. I called the complainant and found out the dog lives at 824 4th. She did not want to knock on the owner's door and get involved. I called dispatch and had an officer make contact and get the dog contained.

Tuesday 1/28/25 Received a message from Cassie with a picture of a dog. It was Dexter from 808 6th.

Friday 1/31/25 I received a call about 2 dogs being abandoned at 525 10th. I left a Notice and sent a message to the owner. She replied back and confirmed the dogs are not abandoned. Neither are the cats. She is moving out and has a home for one of the dogs on Sunday and she is taking the other dog with her.

 - 3. 21 properties failed the initial inspection.
- As of 2/1/25 there are 19 outstanding minor deficiencies
- As of 2/1/25 there are 5 outstanding failed properties to note 3 of these properties have had tenants removed and are in the process of being rehabbed before renting again. As noted above, a 4th will be having tenants removed (property sold via foreclosure) – tenants were given multiple months' notice. The 5th is being reinspected in Feb 2025.

FIRE INSPECTIONS: We 1 final inspection and 2 walk throughs

BURN PERMITS: No burn permits were issued in January

PUBLIC ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS:

We attended a Coast Guard planning meeting with multiple agencies for the River Roots critical incident tabletop event in February.

The promotional process was completed, and Lt. Jeremy Lynn was promoted to Captain and FF/Medic Jordan Ottaway was promoted to Lieutenant. We also hired Paramedic Andrew Siska and FF/EMT(medic student) Andrew Rath to start the first of February.

Fire Board member and former Asst. Chief Mike O'Day was presented with Northern Ky Firefighter Association Lifetime Achievement Award at their annual banquet.

Regretfully, long time member of the Dayton fire department, John David Wiseman lost his battle with cancer and was laid to rest.
