Dayton March 2025 Report

Monday 3/3/25 Hannah Martinez from 812 Vine was in court this morning. She has 30 days in jail conditionally discharged if no offences in the next 2 years. No contact with her neighbor. There will be a civil case for restitution. Also the 2 remaining dogs need to be current on rabies vaccines.

Friday 3/7/25 Received a nuisance call about the community cats in the alley behind 804 6th getting on a rag top car and scratching it. Also a male is spraying the tires. I spoke with the care taker of the cats. We have most all of them TNRed. We need to catch 3 more. I will order some repellant over the weekend.

Monday 3/10/25 I dropped off the repellant to Billy at 804 6th.

Over the weekend I got a text message from Sargent Linkugel about a dog that belongs to Christy Bruce at 1002 3rd. The dog was out and tried to attack a man and his dog near Speers court. I spoke to Ms. Bruce today and the dog in question is Mary Ann. She also has 2 other 6month old pups. I told her all the dogs need a current rabies vaccine and I gave her a week to comply. I explained the dogs can not run loose and hurts another dog or person, she will be liable and cited.

I got a text from Cassie about 2 cats left outside after a person moved at 525 10th. I sent the owner a message. One cat has a tipped ear and the other does not. I spoke to the caretaker they explained the cats were outdoor cats and both should have an ear tip. They still have their stuff at the house and leave food for them on the back porch.

Called Parker at 1004 4th about Tucker needed a rabies vaccine. He will get it when he gets paid.

The shelter got an email about a skinny puppy at 1023 Ervin Terrace. She explained she has video of the pup and that they have had it for about 6 months. I called her and got the video. Her name is Oksana. The pup is skinny. I left a Notice on apartment 1's door. Apartment 2 said they did not own a dog.

Tuesday 3/11/25 I got a call back from my Notice the lady said she had only had the dog for a few weeks, that her kids found it when they went to Circle K. I had her call the shelter to see if they would accept it. She said they said I could bring it in or she could. I called the shelter to verify. Kayla was not there, but the girl on the phone said get a stray contract filled out. I had her sign a stray contract and took a photo of her license. The dog is very thin and has pressure sores on him from confinement. I took him to Petwow to be evaluated. The dogs name is Bruno.

Wednesday 3/12/25 I picked Bruno up from the vet and his stool sample was negative and his bloodwork was normal. The vet wrote a statement that the dog was suffering from malnutrition.

Dropped off educational literature to 804 6th for both parties. Living with community cats for Billy and the county ordinance and best feeding practices for colony caretakers.

Thursday 3/13/25 I got Oksana's email statement signed. I also talked to apartment number 2 at 1023 Ervin Terrace and she claims that apartment 1 has had the dog for months. I asked her to email me that information.

I spoke to 1021 Ervin Terrace and they can confirm that Bruno has been at his residence since last fall. I asked him to email me that information.

There is also an unneutered cat on the porch at 1021 Ervin Terrace. I offered the TNR program for it. We will pick it up next week.

I got a text about 110 8th having 2 vicious dogs and a small wire fence. I met the dogs and there is a coonhound and a german shepherd, both were friendly. The owner is not concerned with them leaving the yard. He was advised.

Friday 3/14/25 got the email from 1021 Ervin Terrace about Bruno and their concerns. Went to the county attorneys office and signed charges against Bruno's owner.

While doing routine patrol I Noticed that 411 4th's gate was not secure and the rottweiler was out in the front yard. I called the owner and drove back around and tried to secure the gate the best I could. I did email Kendra from the animal shelter and Shelli Bezold from the county attorney's office to report this to them because of the open case against the owner.

Monday 3/17/25 While patrolling the area I saw a yorkie type dog on 3rd. I followed it back to 301 Kenton and spoke to the owner. He said the privacy fence is getting fixed this week.

Wednesday 3/19/25 TNR 2 cats from 409 Kenton. 1 orange male and a white and orange female.

Left a Notice at 1220 5th to not abandoned their animals. The sheriff's department is doing a set out Friday.

Friday 3/21/25 Stopped by 610 Berry to check on a situation that happened. Sargent Linkugel sent me a text about a small dog running in the alley and charging other dogs being walked on leash. The owner Garry Hatter told me he had Cujo on a leash and he was getting in the car and Cujo pulled out of his hand. He said it was an isolated incident. I did call the vet and Cujo is current on rabies vaccines until October 2027.

Picked up a neutered male black lab from 409 Kenton. I was able to find the owner at 1012 3rd. the dog's name is Lefty. Dog was given back to owner.

Saturday 3/22/25 Called out for a great dane and boxer mix running loose on 5th. Officer Tony Baldwin had the older boxer mix in custody. I was disregarded because the owner was found they live at 128 8th.

Called out for a DOA female with a small dog at 302 McKinney. The next of kin brother took the dog. I took the dog to 3817 Huntington ave in Latonia.

Tuesday 3/25/25 Saw Hannah Martinez at UDF this morning and asked her if she had gotten the dogs a rabies vaccine yet. She has not.

Wednesday 3/26/25 received a call from a man in the hospital and he is concerned for his dog. The dog is being kept at 921 4th and he said he was told the dog is getting fat and being fed human food and being kicked. I went by and checked on the dog. He is in great shape and looks fine, no limping or indication he is injured. Called the owner Aaron Brown and told him the dog is fine.

Thursday 3/27/25 emailed the county attorney's office about Bruno's case. Wondering were we are with it?

Got a second call from Aaron Brown the man in the hospital about his dog. He is concerned the person watching his dog is not going to give the dog back when he gets out of the hospital. I told him he may

need to call the police to get his property back, but there is nothing I can do right now with him being in the hospital and having no where to take the dog.

Friday 3/28/25 Picked up a cat that got hit by a car at 224 6th. Cat was dragging its back end and very aggressive. Took the cat to Paws and claws vet for euthanasia. Cat was an unaltered male, long haired black and white, no microchip.

Saturday 3/29/25 Picked up a DOA cat from 123 4th. Cat was an orange unaltered male with a blue collar with a bell. No microchip. On Sunday the owner found me on facebook and verified her cat was hit by a car and deceased.

APPROVED/ONGOING PROJECTS	
Velo Apartments	Information on where Riverfront Commons path would go and what the specifications would be were sent to the owners of the Velo Apartments so that the path could be installed per plan. They went ahead and installed sidewalk in the area the path will go. We are coordinating to try to resolve the issue. I spoke with William Morris and explained the situation. He is waiting on what the ask of him will be from the City. 205 305 8402 This is something we'll need to resolve very soon if we are going to ask him to remove what was put in or contribute to the final design. Is Donnie looking into this for us?
6-453 Dayton Riverfront Commons Ph 2 and 3 12' wide concrete bicycle/pedestrian trail and conduit for future lighting from Berry Street to Fourth Avenue. [Designer is KZF]	OKI has approved the idea to combine phases 2 and 3 so they can be constructed together. We have an agreement with SD1 for them to contribute money towards upgrading the path so it can handle their maintenance equipment. This is the latest from KYTC District 6: I have reviewed the bid documents and sent them to Central Office to complete the review. I have some minor initial comments and am waiting to see if Central Office has any additional comments. Once they are able to review, I will send back to Prime AE to address the comments and then we should be ready to request the construction funds and set a letting date. We are extremely close to getting this one out the door.
6-3228 Dayton Pike Sidewalk Connector (Ph 2) New 1500' of 5' sidewalk along west side of Dayton Pike	New stormwater improvements will not tie into the existing poor/private system and will remove water from the existing system. Curb and gutter will be added for safety and to help with stormwater collection. Plans are being finalized and we need to remove the tree debris that was left on the Fennell property. Easements are going to be needed on several properties in order for grading work to be completed. We are putting together the right of way cost estimate so that we can get this approved by KYTC. We are working with SD1 on storm inlet locations to avoid conflicts with their sanitary line. NKWD is installing a new water main through this area that will replace the 2 existing mains. They anticipate the water main project will begin in August. Hopefully PRIME AE will have the plans ready to go to construction as soon as the water main project is completed.
Upper Riverfront Commons Trail Improvements Improve the existing trail at the top of the earthen levee that runs along the south side of Manhattan Boulevard	The project was not selected for funding from OKI this cycle. We had a debrief with OKI on how to score better next cycle. Creating a capital plan that includes projects that will be submitted for grant funding and completing some of the older grant projects are the two best things we can do.
Grant Park Drive Stormwater Mitigation Project	The size of the pipe was upsized so that the project would qualify for SD1's 50-50 match program. The 50- 50 match was approved and the kickoff meeting was held. Hendy still plans to start this month when the ground dries up.

Levee Toe-Drain Project	SD1 did not provide any information. Engineering to meet with Public Works to look in manholes once PW schedule eases up.
7th Street Slide	Recived \$70,000 in funding to put toward the 7th Street Slide geotechnical exploration and engineering design. Design is complete and we have a cost estimate for construction. We need to submit for additional funding for construction. We are working on finalizing a cost estimate so that additional funding from KYTC can be requested. Submitted for CPPP funding consideration and were just notified the project did not recieve funding. We will continue to look for alternative funding options.
Third and Walnut Stormwater Mitigation Project	Design work has been completed and the 50-50 application has been submitted to SD1. They are reviewing and we are waiting on final approvals. They plan to take the project to their boad for consideration at the April board meeting.
Riverpointe Stormwater Improvements	We arehave updated the cost estimate for the work and are waiting on final approval from the HOA to submit the 50-50 cost share application to SD1 for consideration.

Cardinal Engineering has identified a potential red flag with SD1 having a sewer easement where proposed piering would need to go. We may only be able to move forward with the ADA path.
