Dayton April 2025 Report

Tuesday 4/1/25 I have been patrolling by 411 4th and there have been people working in there and the gate has been opened. I called and found out the previous tenants with the rottweiler has been evicted and it is owned by someone new now. I let the court know because he has an open case regarding containing the dog.

I received a complaint that the 2 dogs from 425 3rd got loose and jumped the fence at 426 3rd and attacked her dog. The dog has 3 puncture wounds on its leg and is limping and has a puncture wound on the back of the neck. This is not the first time these dogs have gotten loose and showed aggression. A Dayton officer cited Juanita Rogg to court for 2 counts of control of dog and 2 counts of dangerous animal. Our court date is 4/18/25 at 9am.

Friday 4/4/25 Called for 2 brindle dogs behind the floodwall. Could not find them, but saw on facebook the owners got them back, they live in Bellevue.

Thursday 4/10/25 Got a call about 2 cats living in a car with their homeless owner. I went to the car across from 921 4th and took pictures of the cats and sent to a rescue. They agreed to take them. They are going to Forever homes rescue which is ran by Ashley Goodhew Fogle. Both cats died from a contagious virus.

Messaged Billy at 804 6th about his car and the cat situation.

I stopped by 1002 3rd and found out Christy Bruce has moved with her 3 pit bulls and no longer lives there. They were on my list to get a rabies vaccine. I closed the case.

Monday 4/14/25 Picked up a small black dog from Manhattan on the river. Left a found notice in the clubhouse. Had the property manager sign the stray contract and got a picture of her ID.

Wednesday 4/16/25 TNR male cat from 1021 Ervin Terrace.

TNR small gray female pregnant cat from 134 4th.

Billy from 804 6th sent me a couple pictures of cat hair on his car and another substance on the back of the car. I spoke to Amber and told her we need to fix this issue or she is going to be cited for the nuisance and her landlord is going to be informed. She is buying CAT Mace and going to use that to keep the cats off the car. She also told me that Billy did shoot Blondie, the cat that likes to get on the car, with a BB. Not to hurt her, but to scare her away from the car.

Friday 4/18/25 Had court with Juanita Rogg from 425 3rd. She pleaded guilty and her dogs were deemed dangerous. She already had the dogs microchipped and got a county tag. She still needs to get a beware of dog sign for her yard and keep the dogs in the back yard where the privacy fence is and keep the gate locked.

Saturday 4/19/25 Called by Sargent Linkugel about a malnourished older dog at 6th and Clay. Dog did have a microchip, his name is Shadow, but it came back to a Troy Coleman in Harrison Oh. I asked some kids if they recognized him and they said try up on Brooklyn. I asked a house there and they said he lives at 627 Brooklyn. I left a found dog Notice on their gate. There were 2 other dogs in their yard. The number for the owner has been disconnected. I still tried to call it and send text messages to it. I found a Troy Coleman on facebook and sent messages there. The next day I went back and there was a car in the

driveway and the the other 2 dogs were in the house. I left my card after knocking very hard again. I also saw a message in the concrete that said "Troy loves Amber". Took dog to the shelter.

Sunday 4/20/25 I got a call from police about a dog brought to the fire station. It did not have a chip. I stopped at 334 5th and left a found Notice and checked 501 3rd but they had their dog at home. Took to the shelter they named him Ervin.

Monday 4/21/25 got ahold of Troy Coleman at 627 Brooklyn. He is going to pick Shadow up from the shelter in the morning. Shadow is 14 years old.

Left a found notice for Ervin at 418 5th and at 413 5th. Spoke to several neighbors and they think he might live at 413 5th.

During routine patrol I saw a small white dog with a belly band around 702 Dayton ave. I followed him home to 532 8th. The door was open and another dog was inside. I got ahold of Angela Catacora thru facebook and she got her son to come to the door and get Jax in the house.

Tuesday 4/22/25 Picked up Shadow from the shelter and took back to Troy Coleman at 627 Brooklyn. Due to his weight I did tell the owner I would be rechecking him in a week.

Wednesday 4/23/25 Drove by 425 3rd and she does have a beware of dog sign on the front gate. She has been very cooperative. Registered the dogs with the county as having a bite history.

Thursday 4/24/25 got a complaint from Cassie about 1109 7th. Their dog runs loose and leaves stool in neighboring yards. I was able to speak with the owner thru the ring doorbell. He said his dog escaped the back yard and he will make sure it doesn't happen again.

Friday 4/25/25 The shelter picked up a pitbull with a cone around his neck in Ft. Thomas and someone posted on facebook that the dog lived on Berry in Dayton. I went around several houses on Berry looking for the owner. I did find him at 612 Berry and he had just called the shelter and was going to pick up his dog.

Got a complaint from Cassie about 1021 5th having a strong odor. I went by and left a notice on the front door. I did hear a couple dogs inside barking.

Monday 4/28/25 Left a notice at 812 Ervin Terrace for a dog coming out at a guy walking his dogs on leashes past the house. The dog's name is Buster and he is a French bulldog 11 years old. The owner said the gate is always latched but this time it was not. I called his vet to see if he was current on rabies and he was over due. Advised the owner to get the vaccine asap.

l got to talk to 413 5th and met her 3 dogs. She is not missing a black lab mix hers was in the yard.

Got a call that a dog was left in a house for over 24 hours at 329 Silver. I left an abandonment notice but was informed by the neighbor that someone just came and let the dog out to pee and put it back. He did call me back and he is moving into the house and has not moved his furniture yet. He is caring for the 3 dogs.

Wednesday 4/30/25 Left a Notice at 902 Walnut for leaving a dog out in the thunderstorm last night. He called back and does not own a dog.

Checked 415 4th for a squirrel in a cage. They feed a wild squirrel, but it is not confined.
