## Dayton December Reports 2025

Monday 12/1/25 2 brown dogs were running on the 1100 block of 7<sup>th</sup>. I was able to catch one. Neighbors believed the dogs lived on 6<sup>th</sup>. I went to 6<sup>th</sup> and as I was leaving I saw the dog in front of a house by the railroad tracks. They said the dog lived next door. I got ahold of the owner and gave her dog back at 1013 6<sup>th</sup>.

Tuesday 12/2/25 Picked up a stray dog found at 8<sup>th</sup> and Berry on the Wednesday before Thanksgiving. The dog had a microchip but none of the numbers worked. The dog was adopted from SPCA Cincinnati and named Reese. Took dog to the shelter and posted on Facebook.

Sent email to Dayton admins and counsel about TNR funding.

Wednesday 12/3/25 Spoke to people at 1885 Riverpointe court about the dog named Reese that was picked up they do not know her.

Sent email to Cassie about Petwow bills and what cases they belong to.

Thursday 12/4/25 I was contacted by a Brandon Gibbs and he is Reese's owner. He is going to contact the shelter. He is from Ohio and has no idea how she got to Ky.

Monday 12/8/25 Someone took a dog to the shelter. I recognized the dog it is Milo from 1013 6<sup>th</sup> I picked him up and took him home because his owner doesn't drive.

Dexter was out and I yelled for him to go home and he did. He lives at 808 6<sup>th</sup>.

Tuesday 12/9/25 Shane Patterson from 918 Maple called wanting me to pick up his dog. He has moved and the dog is still at the house. I explained I can not pick up owned dogs and gave him the shelters phone number. I also sent him some no kill rescues for the dog Hatched. I also shared his post on facebook to try and find him a new home. The dog is 10 years old.

Wednesday 12/10/25 Notice to 1220 5<sup>th</sup> for an aggressive pit bull running loose per neighbor. I spoke with the dog's owner and she explained he accidentally got loose that night. The dog is named Jet and current on his rabies vaccine.

Thursday 12/11/25 a lady picked up a dog in front of 1114 4<sup>th</sup> and met me. The dog had a chip and was at least 12 years old. I was able to find the owner at 1112 4<sup>th</sup>.

Monday 12/15/25 Shadow has been forfeited today! I put the court order in his file and sent to Kenton County animal shelter. Shadow has found a new home and will be adopted.

Called out at 1 am for 2 aggressive dogs at Circle K. They were gone when I arrived. I looked for them but could not find them.

Tuesday 12/16/25 Kim Kincaid from 301 3<sup>rd</sup> found a home for her small terrier. She has only got 2 dogs now.

Wednesday 12/31/25 Called out for an abandoned dog getting out of the yard and chasing people at 918 Maple. The dog is Patches AKA Hatchet his owner did move away and has been coming back and feeding and watering the dog at this location. I called the owner while I was on my way to the call. Patches was in his yard and on the porch when I got there. He came right to me wagging his tail. I looked around back to see how he got out and the back door looks kicked in. The owner showed up and told me there were no utilities on at the house and he doesn't know how to contain Patches with the back door being damaged. I know the owner has been trying to find a home for Patches since May 2025. He has a surrender appointment on January 6<sup>th</sup> at the shelter. The shelter said they would not take him if he is old and in bad shape, I called Kendra to verify. Patches is at least 10 years old and has some skin issues due to flea allergies. I called a rescue called Cleo's Legacy and told them the story and they accepted Patches into their group. I got the owner to relinquish ownership in writing and took Patches.

Projects	January 2026 Meeting Update
<b>APPROVED/ONGOING PROJECTS</b>	
<b>TANK Grant</b>	KYTC has requested plan sheets that show exactly where the amenities will be located. Jerrod is working on updating an aerial view to more clearly define where each of the amenities will be located.
<b>Velo Apartments Sidewalk Removal</b>	Public Works to remove the existing sidewalk ahead of the new path being installed as part of Riverfront Commons Phases II and III. This may need to happen sooner than expected if PRUS moves from the riverfront to Manhattan Blvd to allow the additional tree clearing to take place.
<b>6-453 Dayton Riverfront Commons Ph 2 and 3</b> 12' wide concrete bicycle/pedestrian trail and conduit for future lighting from Berry Street to Fourth Avenue. [Designer is KZF]	PRUS has completed the Phase II section and is ready to start on the Phase III section. We are coordinating with them and KYTC to initiate a change order to remove the remaining trees to improve safety and aesthetics. PRUS may move to work on the area along Manhattan Blvd so the tree clearing can take place before the path is installed in this area to avoid the possibility of the heavy equipment damaging the new path.
<b>6-3228 Dayton Pike Sidewalk Connector (Ph 2)</b> New 1500' of 5' sidewalk along west side of Dayton Pike	We have received a couple signed consent and release forms and Mike is following up with the others. AltaFiber said they will get back to us early in 2026 with their plan for pole relocation.
<b>Ramp from Berry Street to Riverfront Commons River's-Edge Trail</b>	Existing geotechnical information has been sent to Andy Casto at UES and we met him on site. He is going to put together a scope and fee for the geotechnical services that will be needed to get the ADA ramp and overlook area installed within the easement and on the City's property.
<b>Upper Riverfront Commons Trail Improvements</b> Improve the existing trail at the top of the earthen levee that runs along the south side of Manhattan Boulevard	The project was awarded grant funding through OKI. Design funds should be authorized sometime after July 1 2026. Mike and Jay to meet with Southbank towards the end of July to start planning for this.
<b>7th Street Slide</b>	Design is complete and we have a cost estimate for construction. We need to submit for additional funding for construction. We are looking into the possibility of using CDBG funding for the retaining wall. LARP grant application was submitted 9.24.25.
<b>Third/Fourth and Walnut Stormwater Mitigation Project</b>	The new storm system has been installed by Eaton. We need to submit reimbursement request to SD1.
<b>Riverpointe Stormwater Improvements</b>	Project is completed. We are working on the as-built plans to submit to SD1 along with the reimbursement request.

2025 Resurfacing	Eaton will need to come back in the spring to do the resurfacing work. We will coordinate with them and NKWD to see if we can add a couple more roadway segments to their list to help with the NKWD restoration.
New Public Works Facility	We met with SD1 on 12/1 to discuss how to handle the stormwater piece. It looks like an underground stormwater detention system will be needed under the proposed parking lot. We are working with the architets to determine the sizing of the storage that will be needed.
Dayton Pike Stormwater Mitigation Project	The project was not selected for funding from OKI this cycle. We had a debrief with OKI and they don't think this is going to be a project that is likely for SNK funding moving forward. We will work with SD1 on a potential public cost share project. Met with Andy Aman 12/1 to discuss.
