## Dayton Report 2026 March

Friday 3/6/26 got a call about a medium sized black dog going after someone on a bike at 5<sup>th</sup> and Walnut. I could not locate the dog.

Monday 3/9/26 got an emailed complaint from the city of Dayton about 301 3<sup>rd</sup>. The complaint said 2 dogs were left outside without food/water and shelter and the dogs look malnourished. I got pictures of the dogs and pictures of food and water outside in the back of the house. There are actually 3 dogs at this address. 2 are vaccinated, the puppy Zeus needs his vaccines.

Sent an email to the county attorney about Veronica Harrington not paying any restitution to the city. I got a court date to come to later this month.

Christy Bruce is back in town. I sent another email about her case and found out she did have an active warrant for 2 counts of Animal cruelty.

Tuesday 3/10/26 Got a call about a black and white shepherd mix seen a couple times on the 800 block of 6<sup>th</sup>. Dexter lives on that block and it could have been him. I did not see anything.

I got a call that 2 brown dogs were at the school near 3<sup>rd</sup> and Clay. I found Milo and Spooky running loose heading home. I was able to get ham from the lady at 1013 6<sup>th</sup> and get them back in the house.

Thursday 3/12/26 got a call that the dog at 1112 4<sup>th</sup> was running loose. When I got there he was back in the yard.

Friday 3/13/26 Got a call from Brenda Hardin at 1112 4<sup>th</sup> about the dog Theo. He is 14 years old and using the bathroom in the house. I told her the shelter was not going to take a dog that old and she may want to consider euthanizing him.

Tuesday 3/17/26 Spoke to Veronica Harrington about restitution. She said she paid the court house the full amount. Cassie did message me that they did receive her payment.

Got a call about a cat on a porch for a few days at 420 3<sup>rd</sup>. The cats name was Melvin and he had a chip. I took him back home to 429 Foote in Bellevue.

Thursday 3/19/26 got a call from the shelter about an injured cat at 224 3<sup>rd</sup>. I could not find the cat so I left a trap. The caretaker Tom Mack was able to catch the cat. I texted Cassie and she said the city did not have the funds for a vet bill. I posted the cat on the rescue group facebook chat and found a rescue willing to take responsibility for the cat. I just needed to get the cat to the vet Saturday at 5 pm. The cat got neutered and his wound which had maggots in it was shaved and cleaned up. Cat is at Furever homes cat rescue.

At 6pm I got a message about Theo from 1112 4<sup>th</sup> being out. I called his owner and told her she would be getting a citation if she can't keep him in. She agreed to keep him in the house.

Thursday 3/26/26 Picked up 4 baby opossums from the back yard at 425 3<sup>rd</sup>. Their dog killed the mother. I disposed of her. Took the babies to a rehabber in Kenton county.

Friday 3/27/26 Called by Cassie for a DOA dog at 10<sup>th</sup> and Ervin Terrace. The dog had a microchip and was right in front of her house at 916 Ervin Terrace. I gave the owners back the dog for burial.

Milo and Spooky were out at Velo Apartments. I did not see them but I saw their pictures on Facebook. They live at 1013 6<sup>th</sup>.

There was also a post on facebook about Dexter from 6<sup>th</sup> being loose. I could not locate him.

Monday 3/30/26 did a bite report for KIKI at 1208 4<sup>th</sup> biting someone while going after their dog being walked on a leash yesterday. She is current on her rabies vaccine. We have a court date in April.

Tuesday 3/31/26 got a call from a sheriff unit that a chihuahua was inside a vehicle parked in a yard behind a fence at 210 4<sup>th</sup>. When I arrived I saw multiple chihuahuas inside the van, I took a picture. The owner came out and said she just put them in there that she was leaving. She did leave with the dogs. They did not seem to be in distress.

<b>APPROVED/ONGOING PROJECTS</b>	
<b>TANK Grant</b>	Because of the costs associate with design and inspection we have decided to turn the grant money back in for this project.
<b>6-453 Dayton Riverfront Commons Ph 2 and 3</b> 12' wide concrete bicycle/pedestrian trail and conduit for future lighting from Berry Street to Fourth Avenue. [Designer is KZF]	PRUS has completed most of the work. The remaining trees will be removed beginning the first week of April. The gradework along the path will be completed once the trees have been removed. Southbank has ribbon cutting tentatively scheued for 5/14.
<b>6-3228 Dayton Pike Sidewalk Connector (Ph 2)</b> New 1500' of 5' sidewalk along west side of Dayton Pike	We only have a few consent and release forms left to be signed. We received the final pole layout from AltaFiber. Prime is checking to make sure the proposed pole locations all work and are also extending the curb and gutter section a little further up Dayton Pike.
<b>Ramp from Berry Street to Riverfront Commons River's-Edge Trail</b>	UES is not being responsive about providing a scope and fee for analyzing the geotechnical aspect of adding this path. APS Geo is another good local geotechnical company. We met with them on site to talk through different options. We are reviewing the available survey data to determine if that is sufficient or if additional survey will be necessary. We will use the available data to coordinate with APS Geo to determine the most cost efficient way to get an ADA ramp installed.
<b>Upper Riverfront Commons Trail Improvements</b> Improve the existing trail at the top of the earthen levee that runs along the south side of Manhattan Boulevard	The project was awarded grant funding through OKI. Design funds should be authorized sometime after July 1 2026. Mike and Jay met with Southbank a couple weeks ago to start planning for this.
<b>7th Street Slide</b>	Design is complete and we have a cost estimate for construction. We need to submit for additional funding for construction. We are looking into the possibility of using CDBG funding for the retaining wall. LARP grant application was submitted 9.24.25. Constructing the wall first and dong temporary pavement restoration may be considered due to budgeting issues.
<b>Third/Fourth and Walnut Stormwater Mitigation Project</b>	The new storm system has been installed by Eaton. We need to submit reimbursement request to SD1 and are just waiting on as built plans from Eaton before the submittal is sent.
<b>2025 Resurfacing</b>	Eaton will be back in town beginning the middle of April to complete the work they didn't get to in the fall. We will coordinate with them and NKWD to see if we can add a couple more roadway segments to their list to help with the NKWD restoration.
<b>New Public Works Facility</b>	We met with SD1 on 12/1 to discuss how to handle the stormwater piece. It looks like an underground stormwater detention system will be needed under the proposed parking lot. We have provided the architects with the sizing of the storage that will be needed.

Dayton Pike Stormwater Mitigation Project	This is eligible for public cost share dollars through OKI. It could be done in phases where we do the curb and storm improvements now and resurface right after that work has been completed.
