

## Dayton Report 2026 May

Friday 5/1/26 set a trap for an injured orange male cat. He has a necrotic wound on the side of his face that needs medical attention. I emailed UCAN and they said to bring him in Monday.

Sunday 5/3/26 Called out by officers for a very large German Shepherd at the Queen city riverboats area. Dog had a chip and was returned home to 212 4<sup>th</sup>.

Monday 5/4/26 Took cat with a face wound to UCAN.

Tuesday 5/5/26 Picked up cat from UCAN and he has stitches and gabapentin he needs to take. I asked the shelter if they would keep him and give him his meds and they said yes. He is a friendly cat and the meds just get sprinkled on his food twice a day.

Gary Hatter from 610 Berry has a dog he needs to get rid of. She is a small white terrier mix. I told him I can't pick up owned animals. I sent him a list of rescues.

Wednesday 5/6/26 Gary Hatter called me and told him the white terrier got loose. Cassie sent me a picture soon after of a dog she found in Jamestown. I told her it lived at 610 Berry. She returned her home. I stopped by to check the dog for a microchip hoping she came from a rescue or shelter that would take her back. She did not have one.

Impounded 2 female shepherd puppies from 934 Walnut. I posted it on facebook and found the owner. The owner was unable to get to the shelter before 10PM when 2<sup>nd</sup> shift leaves, so I picked up the pups and took them home to 942 Maple.

Thursday 5/7/26 Took orange cat with the face wound to rescue today!

Tuesday 5/12/26 got a complaint about a tan pit bull leaving stool on 1032 6<sup>th</sup> porch and running loose. I did not see any dogs out.

Wednesday 5/13/26 got the video of the tan pit bull running loose on 1032 6<sup>th</sup> property. Went next door to 1030 6<sup>th</sup> and left a Notice. The guy that answered the door did not speak English. He called someone name Jamie who I spoke to about the dog getting loose.

Thursday 5/14/26 Theo was running loose at 1112 4<sup>th</sup>. When I got there he was in the yard but the gate was open. I shut the gate and locked it. I left a card for the owner to call me. She did call and I informed her he was out today.

Monday 5/18/26 TNR mother cat that was in heat from 1114 5<sup>th</sup> at UCAN.

Got a complaint about 507 4<sup>th</sup> having 3 puppies outside without food, water or shelter and having a house full of reptiles. He has a business license for selling the reptiles and exotics.

The puppies had food and water. He was informed they needed a dog house. He also was informed of the 3 dog limit. Information was sent to Cassie about the business.

Got a call from Officer Wiley about investigating a dog bite. A sheriff deputy got bit serving a paper at 1103 3<sup>rd</sup>. I spoke to the dog's owner and got his rabies vaccine information, he is current. I discussed the quarantine process with the owner. Dayton did the bite report and sent it to the health dept.

Officer Spears found a black kitten in an abandoned house at 814 5<sup>th</sup>. Hart Rescue took.

Tuesday 5/19/26 got a call from Officer Spears about 2 Shepherds at Elliot coffee. I called Mac's owner and it was their dogs. They went and got them.

Got an email complaint from Cassie about 2 white dogs at 613 O'Fallon running loose in the church garden. Spoke to the owner and advised.

TNR male black cat from 319 9<sup>th</sup> at Ucan.

Caught a tabby kitten at 814 5<sup>th</sup> and sent to Hart rescue.

Thursday 5/21/26 Went by to see Copper 514 2<sup>nd</sup> and to tell Todd Campbell he needs to get him to the vet or face animal cruelty 2<sup>nd</sup> degree charges.

Spoke to Thomas Mack about his cat issue. He has had 9 cats TNRed at the shelter and he says he has more kittens and breeding cats in the neighborhood. An Air BNB at 308 Vine is complaining about the cats. I have set him up with Ashley from Forever homes rescue and she had him appointments for spay and neuter and he never went to any of the appointments. I told him his neighbors need to use deterrents and he needs to focus on TNR. He also needs to put a big litter box in his yard to encourage the cats to go there and not in the neighborhood. I did advise him that he created this problem by feeding cats. He said it started with only 4. I explained he should have TNRed those 4 before it got out of control.

Friday 5/22/26 Picked up an injured sparrow from 814 7<sup>th</sup> and trying to find a rescue for it. There are no close bird rehabs. He had a very bad wound under his wing, possibly a cat attack. Veg said they would euthanize him for me. He was dead when we arrived there.

1114 5<sup>th</sup> messaged me about a sick kitten that was vomiting. It seemed better this morning.

Tuesday 5/26/26 Velo apartments called with a dog. It was Milo from 1013 6<sup>th</sup>. No one was home when I took him back so I left a card on the door. He did call me back later and I had Officer Mangan go with me to drop him off to discuss that they could get cited and the dogs need a current rabies vaccine.

Wednesday 5/27/26 Officer Wiley called me thru dispatch about a shepherd puppy at 9<sup>th</sup> and Thornton. I called the owner and the dog was given back to the owner on Maple.

Friday 5/29/26 Picked up a baby raccoon from 1023 Walnut that was found in a box. Contacted rehab and will take the baby there.

<b>APPROVED/ONGOING PROJECTS</b>	
<b>6-453 Dayton Riverfront Commons Ph 2 and 3</b> 12' wide concrete bicycle/pedestrian trail and conduit for future lighting from Berry Street to Fourth Avenue. [Designer is KZF]	Prus is working on addressing the grading issues and punch list items. We are going to need protective railing on the river side of the path for 300-400 feet. PRIME to send us railing options to consider. Southbank has ribbon cutting tentatively scheuled for 5/19.
<b>6-3228 Dayton Pike Sidewalk Connector (Ph 2)</b> New 1500' of 5' sidewalk along west side of Dayton Pike	We only have a few consent and release forms left to be signed. We received updatedf plans from PRIME and only the driveway at 515 is left to update.
<b>Ramp from Berry Street to Riverfront Commons River's-Edge Trail</b>	We are reviewing the available survey data to determine if that is sufficient or if additional survey will be necessary. We will use the available data to coordinate with APS Geo to determine the most cost efficient way to get an ADA ramp installed.
<b>Upper Riverfront Commons Trail Improvements</b> Improve the existing trail at the top of the earthen levee that runs along the south side of Manhattan Boulevard	The project was awarded grant funding through OKI. Design funds should be authorized sometime after July 1 2026. Mike and Jay met with Southbank a couple weeks ago to start planning for this.
<b>7th Street Slide</b>	Design is complete and we have a cost estimate for construction. We need to submit for additional funding for construction. We are looking into the possibility of using CDBG funding for the retaining wall. LARP grant application was submitted 9.24.25. Constructing the wall first and dong temporary pavement restoration may be considered due to budgeting issues.
<b>Third/Fourth and Walnut Stormwater Mitigation Project</b>	The new storm system has been installed by Eaton. We received the as built information 5.28.26 so we should be ready to submit the reimbursement request to SD1.
<b>2025 Resurfacing</b>	Everything except striping has been completed; including resurfacing Dayton Pike over the areas that were disturbed as part of the NKWD project.
<b>New Public Works Facility</b>	We met with SD1 on 12/1 to discuss how to handle the stormwater piece. It looks like an underground stormwater detention system will be needed under the proposed parking lot. We have provided the architects with the sizing of the storage that will be needed.

<b>Dayton Pike Stormwater Mitigation Project</b>	This is eligible for public cost share dollars through OKI. It could be done in phases where we do the curb and storm improvements now and resurface right after that work has been completed. We have met on site and discussed with SD1. We just need to determine the final scope and get pricing from interested contractors.
<b>Grant Park</b>	We have a scope for the potential next phase. Hendy has provided costs for a portion of the work and is putting together costs for the other piece.
<b>PROPOSED PROJECTS</b>	
<b>RAISE (TIGER) Grant Opportunity</b>	May be advertised for design soon.
<b>Industrial Park Roadway Resurfacing</b>	
<b>Kenton Street at 7th Avenue Alley Replacement</b>	We are coordinating with Cardinal Engineering and the owner to get the work scheduled.
<b>Sargeant Park Stream Mitigation Project</b>
