

Dayton Report 2026 July

Wednesday 7/1/26 Got a call about 406 Walnut having a possible Pomeranian tied out on a short leash. Nothing seen.

Thursday 7/2/26 took Kristin the cat from 500 Dayton Pike to OAR. Still trying to catch the 2nd cat Dave.

Spoke to 302 McKinney about the leash law. They claim to walk their dogs across the street to the empty lot to go potty. The chihuahua won't walk on a leash. They were advised to leash train the dog.

Monday 7/6/26 TNR 3 kittens from 1013 6th 2 females and a male.

Tuesday 7/7/26 Notice at 843 Ervin Terrace for having 4 dogs and not cleaning up the stool from the yard. Owner called me back. One dog belongs to her son.

Got a couple calls about a sick or injured cat on Brooklyn. No chip. Took the cat to Veg for euth. Cat had maggots all over the rear end.

Thursday 7/9/26 Set up a bigger trap at 500 Dayton pike with a trail camera. Cat is definitely active and still in the house.

Friday 7/10/26 got a complaint about 817 Ervin terrace having 4 dogs and yelling at them all the time. She only has 2 dogs and the dogs are young and will bark if she doesn't stay on them.

Picked up a skinny female tabby kitten with a bloody nose and goopy eyes from 301 3rd. Sweet dream house rescue took the kitten and got it medical care.

Monday 7/13/26 put new batteries in the trail cam at 500 Dayton pike.

Wednesday 7/15/26 TNR a mother cat from 1317 5th.

Checked on some dogs at 1032 3rd. complaint that they were left out in the heat with no water or shade and one white dog is skinny. There is a pot in the back yard the owner has water in it. He said they go out to potty and right back in. 2 of the dogs are a good weight the white one is a little thin. However, he is very hyper. There was a large bag of dog food in the house. Will monitor.

Thursday 7/16/26 Todd Campbell from 514 2nd street finally took his dog to the vet. The dog had lost its hair and was itchy. The vet said it was allergies and he may never grow his hair back.

Friday 7/17/26 searched the house at 500 Dayton pike for Dave the cat with Officer Howell. Could not locate him. Left the trap set with temptations cat treats.

Sunday 7/19/26 Finally caught Dave in the trap! Took to OAR adoption center.

Wednesday 7/22/26 TNR female kitten from 134 4th.

Got a complaint that a dog was left in a house at 621 5th. The owner called me back and said he is taking care of the dog, but doesn't live there.

Thursday 7/23/26 Milo from 1013 6th was running loose. Cassie sent me a picture of him. He did go back home.

Friday 7/24/26 I received a bite report and police report about a dog bite. Unfortunately the dog owner left the scene with the black pit bull type dog and we have no owner information.

Picked up 2 baby squirrels from 806 7th. Got a transport to take them to Grit and Grace wildlife rehab. The lady that found them called back and found another. I was able to drop it off on my way to Tennessee.

An owner posted on facebook that her dog was going to die because she could not afford medical treatment. She lives at 509 4th. I told her she needed to take the dog to the vet or get charged with Animal Cruelty 2nd degree. She did take the dog to VEG on Saturday 7/25/26. Dog is back to normal now.

Fire Chief's Report for July 2026

Responses:

We made **192 responses: 64 fire and 128 EMS runs**. Year-to-date totals are **359 fire incidents** and **830 EMS responses** for a combined total of **1,189 emergency responses**.

Training:

Department personnel continued monthly training focusing on emergency medical operations, fireground operations, apparatus operations, and rescue readiness. Paid staff have accumulated **1,153.5 training hours year-to-date**.

CPR:

No classes this month.

Inspections:

The Fire Prevention Bureau continued inspections and code enforcement activities throughout Bellevue and Dayton. 11 Inspections focused on life safety systems, occupancy compliance, emergency access, and fire code requirements to improve the safety of residents, visitors, and businesses.

Community Outreach:

- FF/Medic Alex Hassert has our Jr Firefighter program up and running with 3 participants.
- Department personnel continued community engagement efforts throughout Bellevue and Dayton.
- Fire prevention and risk reduction information was shared during inspections and public interactions.
- Personnel continued building relationships with local businesses, property managers, schools, and community organizations through routine contacts and fire prevention activities.
- Department social media platforms continued providing emergency information, department updates, fire prevention messaging, and community event information to residents throughout both cities.

Events:

- Responded to **64 fire incidents** throughout the district.

- Handled **128 EMS responses** during July.
- Responded to **1 structure fire**.
- Assisted neighboring communities with **5 move-up assignments**.
- Leading EMS call types included **22 sick person calls, 21 falls, 13 injury calls, and 10 difficulty breathing calls**.
- Continued fire prevention, inspection, training, and community risk reduction efforts in both cities.

6-453 Dayton Riverfront Commons Ph 2 and 3 12' wide concrete bicycle/pedestrian trail and conduit for future lighting from Berry Street to Fourth Avenue. [Designer is KZF]	All work is complete except we need protective railing on the river side of the path for at least 300-400 feet. PRIME to send us railing and landscaping buffer options to consider. They said they were waiting on options from their landscape architect.
6-3228 Dayton Pike Sidewalk Connector (Ph 2) New 1500' of 5' sidewalk along west side of Dayton Pike	We only have two consent and release forms left to be signed. Final plans from PRIME were submitted to KYTC on 6.25.26. Once KYTC approves the plan, we can put it out to bid for construction.
Ramp from Berry Street to Riverfront Commons River's-Edge Trail	Contracts for topographic survey and geotechnical work have been approved. Survey is the frist step and it should be completed within the next month. We will use the survey data to coordinate with APS Geo to determine the most cost efficient way to get an ADA ramp installed.
Upper Riverfront Commons Trail Improvements Improve the existing trail at the top of the earthen levee that runs along the south side of Manhattan Boulevard	The project was awarded grant funding through OKI. Design funds should be authorized sometime after July 1 2026.
7th Street Slide	We are ready to put the project out to bid. We just need to figure out the city's preferred advertisement and due dates. We will continue to look for funding opportunities to help with the roadway restoration. LARP is an option. Applications for LARP are due by October 1.
Third/Fourth and Walnut Stormwater Mitigation Project	We are working on the reimbursement request with SD1.
2025 Resurfacing	Complete
New Public Works Facility	Work/discussion are ongoing.

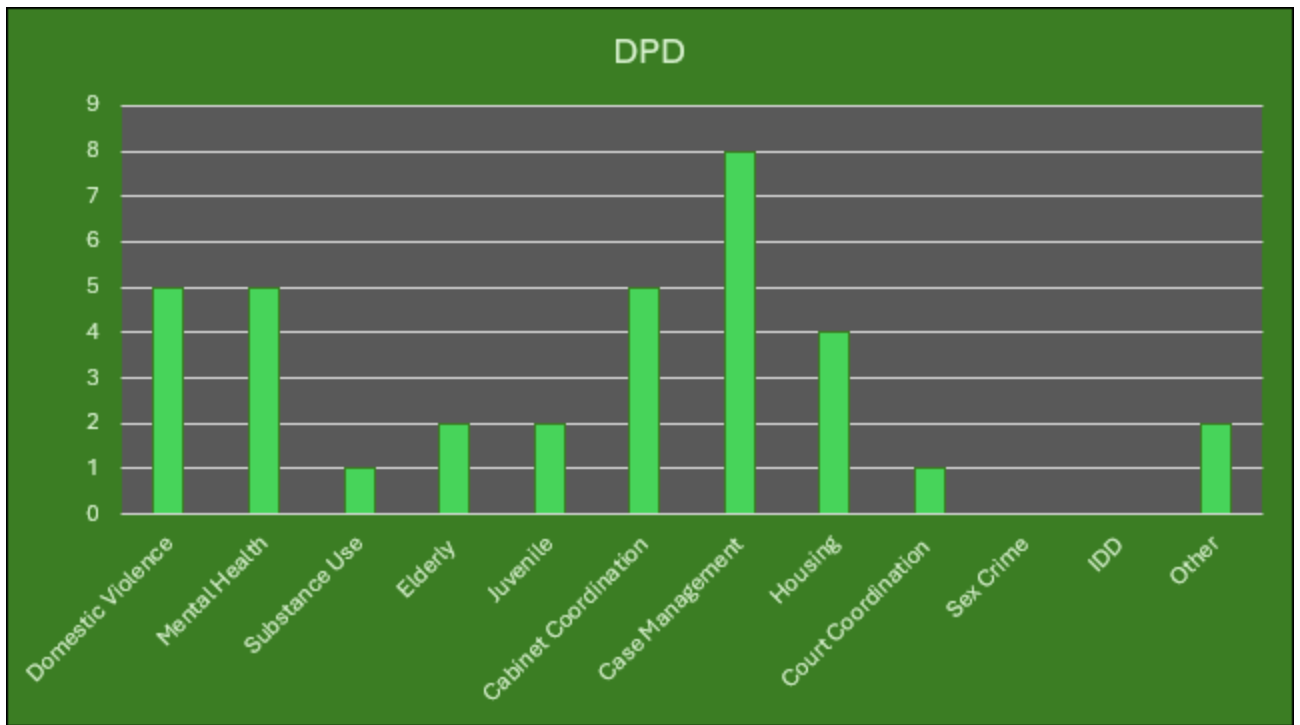
